Target Audience

- Identify the potential risks associated with dermal filler lip augmentation procedures
- Recognize normal side effects versus complications
- Explain how to manage adverse events associated with lip augmentation procedures
- Discuss integration of safety protocols for all cosmetic/aesthetic procedures
